

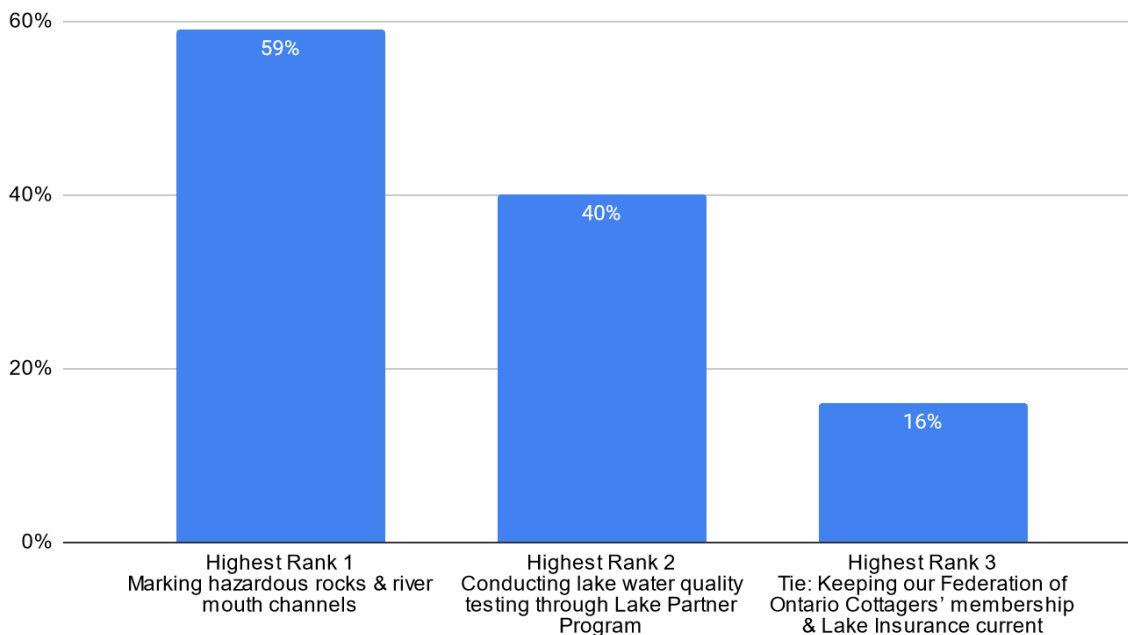
## **Summary Results from 2024 CLCA Survey**

We received 70 responses from the 2024 CLCA Survey and if we base that on the existing CLCA Members in good standing at the time, it was a 35% return rate. We thank those that took the time to complete the survey.

The CLCA Executive Committee are elected and volunteer their time and effort to help sustain Cordova Lake for future generations. ### Top 3 Highest Ranked: Activities the CLCA Should Be Involved In

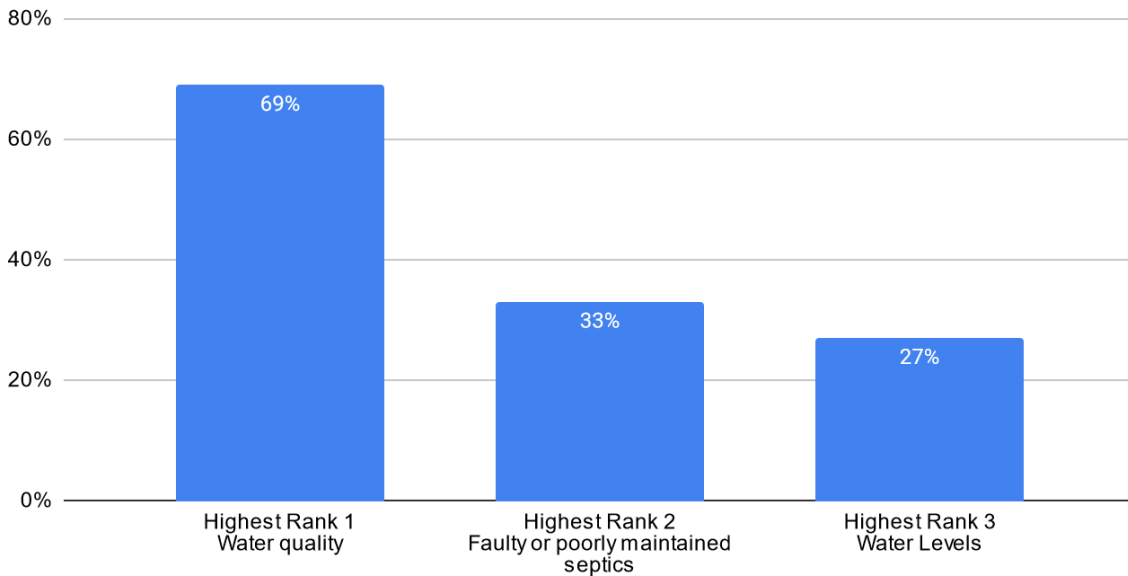


The above chart identifies the top 3 highest ranked activities the CLCA should be involved in:

1. Marking hazardous rocks & river mouth channels.
  - We already do this, in 2024 we started replacing some of our existing markers with the new Transport Canada approved Hazardous Buoys, including "Danger Rock" labels
  - We also included two more rock locations in our inventory of rocks to be marked.
  - We plan to purchase some more markers in 2025.

2. Conducting lake water quality testing through the Lake Partner Program.
  - We already do this testing, which is for phosphorous & clarity.
  - In 2024, we also started doing E.coli testing and a separate article will be included in the 2024 Fall/Winter Newsletter about this.
3. Keeping our Federation of Ontario Cottagers' membership & Lake Insurance current.
  - We will continue to keep both of these current.

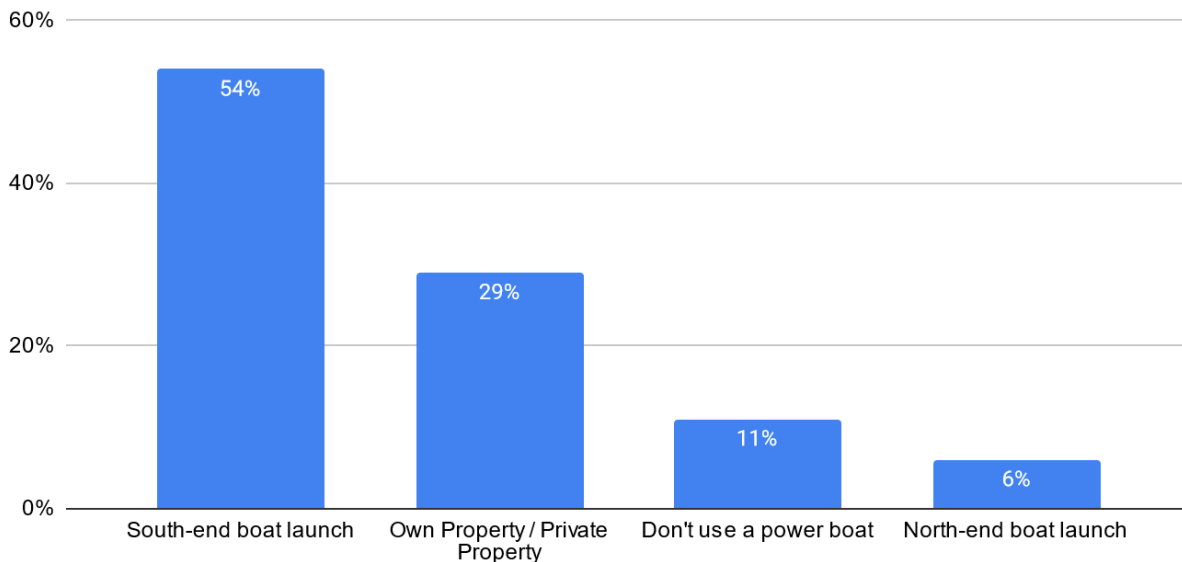
### Top 3 Highest Ranked: Issues Facing Our Lake & Your Lake Use



The above chart identifies the top 3 highest ranked issues facing our lake and your lake use:

1. Water Quality
  - Same comments as under 2 for the first chart.
2. Faulty or poorly maintained septic systems
  - Now that managing septic systems is coming under Township of Havelock-Belmont-Methuen (HBM) control, we will find out the process they plan to use for determining / reporting faulty or poorly maintained septic systems.
3. Water Levels
  - We will see if we can get more information from Crowe Valley Conservation Authority (CVCA) on how they determine when to add or remove logs at the dam at the south-end of Cordova Lake.

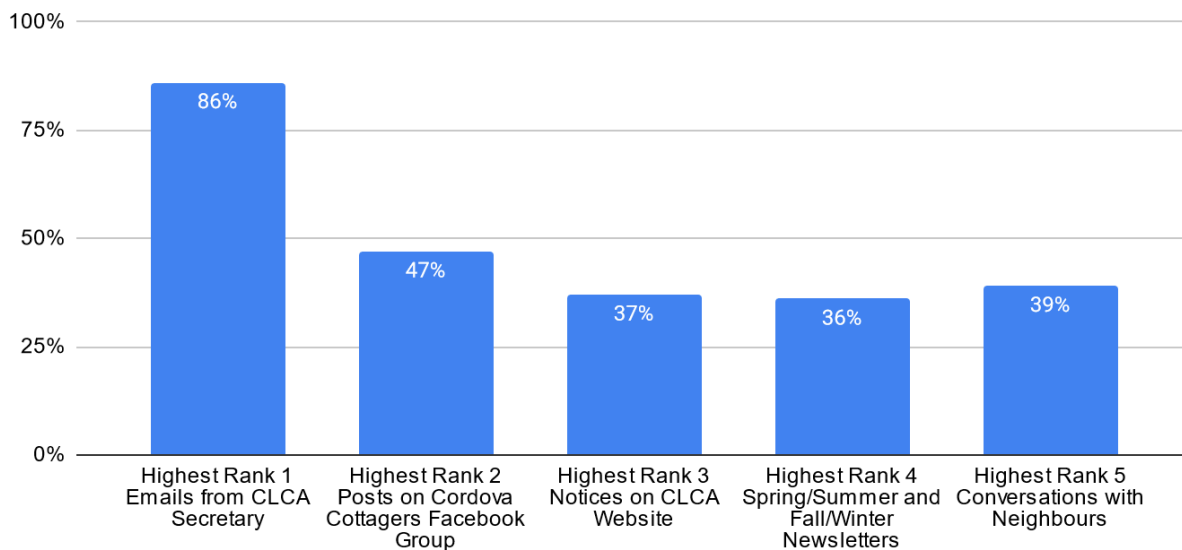
## Percentage: If You Use A Power Boat Where Do You Launch Your Boat



The above chart identifies where the respondents launch their power boat, if they use one.

- Over 50% of the respondents launch their power boat at the South-end boat launch, which is not surprising, as that is the main location for launching boats on Cordova Lake, which is not privately owned. It is Crown Land, which is managed by the Ministry of Natural Resources (MNR).
